Notes:

1. **Indonesia** acceded to the Convention on 5 October 2021. In the ordinary course, the Convention will enter into force for Indonesia on 4 June 2022.
2. **Denmark** has declared that the Convention does not yet apply for Greenland, which is a self-governing Danish overseas administrative division.
3. **New Zealand** has declared that the Convention does not apply for Tokelau, which is a self administered New Zealand Territory.

APOSTILLES ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR AUSTRALIAN NOTARIAL ACTS DESTINED FOR SOME COMMONWEALTH JURISDICTIONS

Even though they are party to or subject to the Apostille Convention, the following Commonwealth jurisdictions do not require apostilles to be affixed to Australian notarial acts to be produced within their territories, namely:

Anguilla, Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, Belize, Bermuda, Botswana, Brunei Darussalam, Cayman Islands, Dominica, Eswatini, Fiji, Gibraltar, Grenada, Lesotho, Malawi, Montserrat, New Zealand, St. Kitts and Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent & The Grenadines, Singapore, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Turks and Caicos Islands and the United Kingdom.
